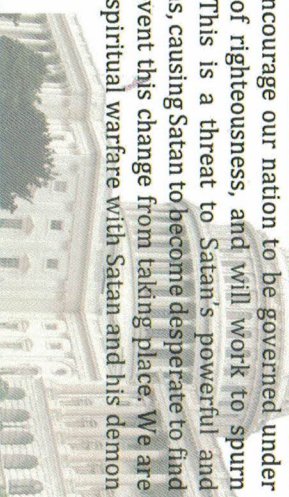
Anger and Outrage

Sadly, political powers have added to the chaos we find in today's world by not understanding God's Plan of Salvation. Thus the children of God must try to learning what God wants us to do about what we are witnessing, how we should handle the concern we feel, and how we should manage the anger and outrage we experience.

It is a fallacy to think that these emotions (anger and outrage) have no place in the Christian heart because scripture shows us that God Himself was angered and outraged by the sin He saw in the world in Noah's day and sent the flood in response. Scripture also shows us that God was outraged when He saw the sin of Sodom and Gomorrah and again took action.

God was deeply saddened by this destruction and by the demise of sinners and holds the desire to see the sinner repent rather than be destroyed. God has promised to endure the sins of mankind until Christ returns thus provide all people with the opportunity to learn and make changes in their lives through their personal experience with evil. Through these experiences many will change their ways while others will remain blind to the truth and accept what Satan cunningly places in their hearts and minds. (Corinthians 4:4)

However, many desire to elect politicians and create a government which will honor God, turn back to Biblical principles, encourage our nation to be governed under God's rules of righteousness, and will work to spurn corruption. This is a threat to Satan's powerful and ungodly plans, causing Satan to become desperate to find a way to prevent this change from taking place. We are therefore in spiritual warfare with Satan and his demon workers!



Scripture tells us that to fight such a war we must be equipped with the armor of God through actively seeking to understand what God asks of us and how we should behave as we enter into our battles. Here are some Bible verses which help us understand:

1. God tells us what to look for in a leader. (11 Chronicles 19:5-7 tells us, "And he set judges in the land throughout all the fenced cities of Judah, city by city. And said to the judges, Take heed what ye do: for ye judge not for man, but for the Lord, who is with you in judgment. Wherefore now let the fear of the Lord be upon you: take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the Lord our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts.") In these verses God clearly issues a warning to those who govern. They are told to fear God and govern according to His will. 11 Chronicles 19:10 adds, "...between law and commandments, statutes and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the Lord, and so wrath will come upon you, and upon your brethren; this do, and ye shall not trespass

2. God tells us to flee sin. Psalms 9:16-17 warns, "The Lord is known by the judgment which he executeth; the wicked is ensnared in the work of his own hands....The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God." Here we are warned that wicked lawmakers will be ensnared by the power of Satan, and that those who knowingly vote for them and thus allow our lawmakers to act in evil ways, will also be ensnared. It tells us that our nation will suffer from what those wicked lawmakers and our thoughtless votes have wrought.

3. God tells us to build walls to protect against corruption (sin). Nehemiah 2:17 says: "Then I said unto them, Ye see the distress that we are in, how Jerusalem lieth waste, and the gates thereof are burned with fire: come let us build up the wall.....", and in Isaiah 26: 2, "Open up the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the truth may enter in".

4. God tells us that we must teach our children of Him. Matthew 18:6 warns, "But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged around his neck, and that he drowned in the depth of the sea." This scripture tells us that those who are responsible for harming God's children by word or deed will be held accountable. It is a

dire warning to those who are responsible for removing God, prayer, and the Biblical principles upon which this nation was founded from schools, textbooks, government buildings and gatherings. It is also a warning to those who work to ban prayer, Nativity sets, and crosses from government land and a warning to those who pass laws supporting sinful behavior.

5. God tells us that the end times will be rampant with sin. Malachi 2:8 acknowledges, "But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, sayeth the Lord of hosts." It is time for all Christians to move back to God's admonitions and do what they can to stop the corruption so evident in our lawmakers and throughout our government.

6. God tells us that we must don His armour to withstand the end times. Malachi 2:17 warns, "Ye have wearied the Lord with your words....When you say, Every one that doeth evil is good in the sight of the Lord, and he delighteth in them; or Where is the God of judgment?" Here God acknowledges that we are complaining about our situation and that our complaining wearies Him because we ourselves have allowed our Biblical principles to be taken from our nation.

7. God tells us what He will provide for us if we stand firm. 11 Chronicles 7:14 comforts us with the words, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." Clearly God is offering us a second chance to stop the wickedness occurring throughout our land through our wicked lawmakers and a chance to turn back to God. If we add the works of prayer and actively seek and follow God words to accomplish this, He will heal our nation.

8. God tells us not to covet what others have. Exodus 18:21 teaches, "Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of ten." This verse tells us to support and vote for those who value truth, who fear (worship) God, and who do not covet what God has bestowed upon someone else!

In addition to what scripture tells us, we must take it upon ourselves to uncover corruption, and what is not in accordance with God's statutes. We must not allow fancy words, charming manners, good looks, highly placed supporters, or financial donors to become important enough to give someone a position of leadership.

To do so, we must research what we do not fully understand, and learn from past errors. Despite others questioning our motives, and claiming that we employ hate or racism, we must ask questions and compare the answers to Biblical standards. For example we might ask if certain records in the history of a candidate have been hidden and not available to us and if so why. We must ask why a candidate may have been disparred or fired. We must ask if the "religion" which a candidate embraces follows what the Bible tells us. (ie: James Cook, founder of a religion which mimics Iran's religious goals).

We must investigate how socialism has worked in other countries, and what demands it has eventually required of its followers. (ie: Venezuela) We must learn what the interest payment on our 20 trillion dollar debt is and how the candidate will pay it down. We must ask why people from other countries and health care systems come to the United States for their health care.

We must learn about the family ties of a candidate (parents, brothers, sisters, friends and other relatives) to help us determine his or her true character. We must research the writings of progressives such as Van Jones, Saul Alinsky, and know the statistics of broken families in minority communities and how welfare contributes to this problem. We must analyze what a potential candidate says and does regarding God and their faith today, and if their future plans for our country will correct present mistakes and adhere to Biblical principles. We must ask why prayer and the pledge of allegiance have been removed from our schools, why "In
