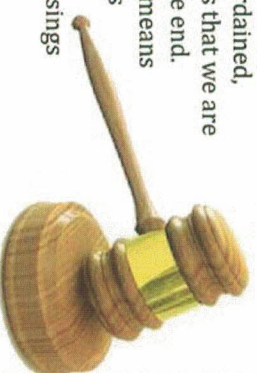


## Scriptures and Politics

God has provided not only for us, but also for our country and it also includes the need for us to apply what scripture dictates. The freedom represented by our right to vote is a blessing from God. To negate that blessing would be devastating to our country and its people. Voting therefore is not only a right and a privilege, but also a thankful response for the blessing God has bestowed upon us. It demonstrates our application of scripture! Defending Biblical values is also our task.

On November 8th of 2016, we who live in the United States of America will have the privilege of voting for a new leader and also choosing those who will retain or gain a position in our Senate or our House of Representatives. Before that vote takes place we will witness the personal campaigns and huge amounts of money provided to support the candidates and must remember that much of what is said will not be true, and worse, that which is true will be severely attacked and portrayed as an untruth. The lies of course, will be as enticing as those offered to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.

Interestingly, scripture does indeed refer to our responsibilities to our nation and to choosing those who govern God's people. In fact, there are at least seven references to this subject in scripture. Even more commanding is what is woven into these verses which point directly to us: "thou shalt provide...." (meaning that we the people shall provide), and "ye shall warn them...." (indicating that we who place these people in office must warn them), and "my people shall...." (indicating that the children of God shall perform certain duties to insure the healing of their land).

Exodus 18:21 teaches, "Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of ten." This clearly tells us to support and vote for those who value truth, who fear (worship) God, and who do not covet what God has bestowed upon someone else! This clearly warns against the redistribution of wealth which many politicians

endorse while providing themselves with an exception.

11 Chronicles 19:5-7 tells us, "And he set judges in the land throughout all the fenced cities of Judah, city by city. And said to the judges, Take heed what ye do; for ye judge not for man, but for the Lord, who is with you in judgment. Wherefore now let the fear of the Lord be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the Lord our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts." In these verses God clearly issues a warning to those who govern. They are told to fear God and govern according to His will.

11 Chronicles 19:10 adds, "...between law and commandments, statutes and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the Lord, and so wrath will come upon you, and upon your brethren; this do, and ye shall not trespass." Here scripture tells us that where governing occurs, no trespass upon God must occur. Thus those who prevent prayer, prevent the word "God" or "Christ" used in any public setting, those who disallow the Nativity on government property, and those who encourage sin, pass laws allowing sin, and those who lie will suffer God's wrath and should not be those whom any child of God should vote for.

Psalms 9:16-17 warns, "The Lord is known by the judgment which he executeth; the wicked is ensnared in the work of his own hands....The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God." Here we are warned not only that wicked lawmakers will be ensnared, but that those who knowingly vote for them and thus allow our lawmakers to act in evil ways, will also be ensnared and our nation will suffer from what those wicked lawmakers and our thoughtless votes have wrought.

11 Chronicles 7:14 comforts us with the words, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." Clearly God is offering us a second chance to stop the wickedness occurring throughout our land through our wicked lawmakers and a chance to still turn back to God. If

we add the works of prayer and actively seek and do God words to accomplish this, He will heal our nation.

Malachi 2:8 acknowledges, "But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, sayeth the Lord of hosts." It is time for all Christians to move back to God's admonitions and do what they can to stop the corruption we see in our lawmakers and our government. It is through the complacency and inaction of many of the children of God that this corruption has been allowed to flourish. God notices those who have been corrupt and He also notes who and what caused our nation and people to stumble.

Matthew 18:6 warns, "But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged around his neck, and that he drowned in the depth of the sea." This scripture tells us that those who are responsible for harming God's word, or God's children, by word or deed will be held accountable. It is a dire warning to those who are responsible for removing God, prayer, and the Biblical principles upon which this nation was founded from schools, textbooks, government buildings and gatherings. It is also a warning to those who work to ban prayer, Nativity sets, and crosses from government land and those who pass laws supporting sinful behavior.

Malachi 2:17 warns, "Ye have wearied the Lord with your words....When you say, Every one that doeth evil is good in the sight of the Lord, and he delighteth in them; or Where is the God of judgement?" Here God acknowledges that we are complaining about our situation and that our complaining wearies Him. He tells us that our complaints will be of no avail because we ourselves have allowed our Biblical principles to be taken from our nation.

Further, in Matthew 22:21 we can read: "Render therefore unto Caesar the things that are Caesar's." This tells us that if we are given the privilege to vote by our government, then we must do so. But we must also remember that the freedom which allows us to vote is God-given and it is something which we can easily lose, especially since we now see that voter
