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## WHY DOESN'T GOD STOP THE EVIL

The Bible tells us about the "End Times" which is a period of great evil just prior to Christ's return. It will be a time when even those with great faith will ask why God does not step in to stop the terrible evils in the world. Our belief that God is all powerful, omnipotent, omnipresent and hates evil make us wonder why evil has been granted so much power...so much freedom.

However, our faith is also based in the belief that God has a reason for what He does, and what He allows. We therefore trust that He understands our struggle to accept His decisions which includes what we see in today's world such as Christians beheaded, children starving, young women kidnapped and raped, the failure of law and order, riots running rampant, and terrible corruption existing in our political system. God knows that as we witness these evils, we will wonder when God will act and say that enough is enough.

Sadly, the world has become so dangerous, and honor and decency has become so scarce, that many have lost their faith simply by what appears to be God's lack of intervention and concern. Many have long expected a demonstration of God's anger against, and His power over, evil, and have been disappointed. And others have ceased to testify

because they cannot provide a reason for why such a powerful God appears complacent in the face of such heartache.

These circumstances make it difficult for faithful Christians to maintain their faith, but also difficult for those newly seeking God to develop and strengthen their faith. For many who begin their quest to know God, it seems impossible to trust God for protection: to believe that God loves us and works toward our well being when they see evil thriving, prevailing and often rewarded!

While many struggle with such thoughts, few openly ask this question or seek this answer. Few openly admit their doubts because they do not want to appear weak in faith. However, these inner thoughts can diminish the staunchness of one's faith and place into the heart a battery of concerns which can destroy the trust which we have long struggled to build. That is why we must not allow these questions to go unanswered.

Christianity is based upon the plan which God instituted to create a people who will freely love Him and one another. God's Plan of Salvation is to span a defined number of years during which man will learn both good and evil and through his free will, choose one or the other. When God's Plan of Salvation is fulfilled, evil will be bound forever and those who trusted God and lived their life as best they could under the grace which Christ's sacrifice provided would be rewarded by living in a kingdom where no sorrow nor tears (no evil) exists.

However, in today's world, Christianity is being vehemently attacked by those whose religion teaches that one must personally engage in the destruction of all who do not believe as they do. This doctrine of hate which Satan has built has become so strong that it has reached millions

willing to sacrifice their own lives to kill Christians.

God understands this danger and despite its influence, remains in control and is still working to bring His Plan of Salvation to fruition. Newly discovered information about Christianity, found in an archeological dig in Galilee, support our belief that Jesus is wholly human and created to experience every emotion which we ourselves experience. As a result, Jesus is implicitly understanding of what we go through since He too experienced every human emotion.

Through His experience, Christ could relay to God the totality of the human experience. Thus we can rest assured that we are understood; that we can believe that our fear and hate, our love and passion, our lust and anger are fully understood by God. And that our struggles to overcome is also understood.

In fact, God also understands that sometimes our confusion is so great that we long for specific answers to our questions and specific direction for our lives. We seek definitive answers and want to see results. We seek ways to learn and do so through scripture, church services, books, magazines, ministers, television, radio and even songs. Television shows us the horrors which exist world-wide through its visual impact on our senses, often stunning us with the extent of evil which exists in man. What we now witness leaves no doubt about evil's intensity and its unfairness. What we see is mind-boggling to the gentle heart of the Christian.

Thus, as we move forward in today's world personally watching our lives becoming more and more aware of the terrible injustices and evil we see and even personally experience, we are afraid. We not only see that evil exists but that it thrives! Our struggle to believe, to stay faithful to what we've been taught becomes a task we are no longer sure we can master. This reaction is not because

we are not willing to stay the course or even to believe, but because we no longer know how to think, what to think, or how to be role models. We wonder if we really can teach God's Plan of Salvation, and successfully assure others that God loves us despite what He is allowing to occur.

Scripture warns that circumstances will worsen until the 1000 years of peace occurs and that many of the elect of the Lord may be lost. This tells us that while we may believe that our faith is strong enough to weather these times, we need to be vigilant and prepare for an attack on our trust in God. We must understand that such an attack will be far worse than we can now imagine. We can only do this by learning, by understanding what is happening and why.

However, the good news is that we know that God encourages us to test him, tells us to ask and we shall receive. He tells us to seek and we will find. He warns us that we can be lost through a "lack of knowledge" thus encourages us to learn. This tells us that as we move through these terrible evil filled times, we must plead with God through prayer asking Him to open our understanding and guide us to the answers to keep us strong and faithful, provide the knowledge of which He speaks.

We need to ask God to help us recognize the validity of His Plan of Salvation, understand why He has allowed evil to run rampant, and why He allows evil to overpower us for now. We need to tell our Heavenly Father that we truly seek this knowledge and desire this understanding so we can be effective as children of God. And we need to come to Him with a pure and open heart when we speak in this manner.

When we present ourselves to God through a humble, contrite, and seeking heart, He will bless us and open the doors for us to understand. Thus, we will become stronger in our faith and more effective
