## Why The Chaos?

Our lives are so busy that the slow invasion of a changing, evil world seems to have slipped past us without much fanfare. We have been bombarded by the Middle East being afire with war, South America battling for solvency, Europe struggling with its immigrant problems, and the United States burdened with debt, joblessness and godlessness.

We no longer find respite through the strength of our faith, or even the simple act of sitting on the front steps at night and greeting our neighbors. We no longer have imprromptu glasses of homemade lemonade ready for guests; we no longer teach respect for elders, teachers, and police officers; we rarely read or teach Scripture to our children...and we do not pray as we once did.

Nevertheless, we ask why the world is in such chaos. We ask when did this happen, why didn't we notice earlier and what can we do about it? We blame others for the horrors we see. We commiserate over corrupt politicians, the loss of a government led by God and the implementation of the Constitution He gave us. We prefer "feel good" churches instead of the teachings which help us find grace. And sadly parents have become so

permissive that respect, self-discipline and proper behavior is lost to their children and schools pass students despite their lack of achievement.





But to correctly understand what is occurring and will yet occur, we must go back to scripture for the explanation. Scripture explains the twofold nature of these circumstances. One is that Satan wants our lives to be so busy that we do not make the time to learn of God, His plan for us and how we are to live our lives. Two is that God has instituted a plan which WILL unfold and WILL be completed with or without us!

It is through scripture that God tells us why Satan is the instigator and initiator of the world's chaos and why Our Heavenly Father allows Satanic activity to achieve His goal of creating of mankind a worthy Bride for Christ. Thus God uses this time and these circumstances to teach us the difference between good and evil and give us the opportunity to prove our loyalty to God and the good which He advocates.

Scripture tells us that we must prepare ourselves and those around us to stand firm during the chaos we are experiencing and the horrors of what is yet to come. Scripture also explains God's Plan of Salvation for mankind which clearly defines what is required for us to be found worthy when Christ returns and tells us that Christ will return just prior to the worst horror and destruction our planet has ever known.

While God wishes that all of mankind can be saved, He warns that many will be lost due to their lack of knowledge about His offer of salvation and the pre-requisites to being found worthy. (Hosea 3:6). Luke 17:26-32 teaches that the people did not pay attention to God's words when the flood came, Genesis 18 and 19 tell us that people did not pay attention when Sodom and Gomorrah was destroyed and sadly Scripture tells us that the same will occur as we await the return of Christ.

In fact Luke 17:34-36 describes two people working in the field and that only one of these two will be taken. Matthew 25:1-13 tells the parable of the ten virgins....all faithful....all believing....all waiting....yet

only five were prepared and could be taken at the First Resurrection. Matthew 24:21 tells of our current times, "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world, to this time, no nor ever shall be."

Matthew 24:15 states: "When ye therefore shall see the abomination of the desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet...." Nevertheless we are comforted by the words in Revelation 7:14: "These are they which come out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the lamb."

These verses tell us that these times will result in a horror never before seen but that if we can withstand the evil by wearing the "armor" God offers us, and have sought the forgiveness of our sins, and prepare ourselves properly, God will bring us through all that we must endure.

Sadly, much like before the flood and before the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah, many believe that if they live a good life and do what they believe is morally acceptable, they have done all God can expect of them. They are content in this. The Bible however tells us something quite different by describing a specific code of behavior and the importance of an actual "relationship" with God. Such a relationship is built upon the love between a father and his child, and between a husband and a wife. Those relationships flourish on love and on trust.

Neither love nor trust can be built simply by words but must be developed over time and through a deeper knowledge about one another. Mere "acceptance" that "God is God" is not enough and to God represents a complacency which He deems is "neither hot nor cold". In fact, scripture tells us that complacency will bring about the "gnashing of teeth" once someone realizes that they will not be found worthy when Christ returns. Taking God for granted will not bring us the victory we long for.

Luke 21:9-12 says: "Ye shall hear of wars and commotions....Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom....great earthquakes....famines....and pestilences....signs from heavens....they shall lay hands on you and persecute you....." Luke 21:36 warns: "Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape these things that shall come to pass."

God's love for us is so great that He provides all we need to change our ways. Revelation 2:21 tells us: "And I gave her space to repent....". There is yet another warning to us in Revelation 8:9: "And the third part of the creatures which lived in the sea and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed...." and in verse 12: "...and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the star; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the sun shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise."

No one can imagine how frightening this will be to those who do not know scripture nor understand God's plan of Salvation, nor God's promise of protection to His children. Revelation 9:6 says: "And in those days shall men seek death...desire to die...." Thus we should seek Holy Baptism, Holy Communion (taken worthily) and Holy Sealing and learn of God's Plan of Salvation. (Acts 2:38-39) We must provide this to our children as well.

There will be very difficult times ahead, but if we seek God and openly ask Him to guide us, He promises in Isaiah 42:6: "I will hold thine hand". And in Jeremiah 33:5: "Call to Me and I will answer you." Satan is strong and powerful and filled with venomous hatred for the children of God....but he will not prevail in the end and evil will be bound forever when God's plan is completed. Seek therefore sound doctrine and prove what you see and hear to know that they are God's instruction and not those of a false "feel-good" modern day prophet. (1 Peter 5:8) Satan WANTS your complacency, he WANTS you to feel overwhelmed
